Yes I was told verbally by the deputy nurse of the ward that my leave has been increased to 5 days a week from 9am till 7pm but still have to come my relatives for me and can come back by myself or vice versa, go home by myself and bring me back my relatives. So at the end I will still end going out only twice a week because my relatives have other things to do. This development came after I reported the Minister to the Commissioner of Standards in public life that he was intentionally discriminating me and even told him that I have 3 persons as witness of this intentional discrimination. But unfortunately when asked him again if he will send for these witnesses to testify, he (the Commissioner) simply said that he cannot take action on what happened before a certain date, etc.
