



FORMAL CANONICAL ESCALATION: Dossier on Ecclesiastical Misconduct, Systemic Institutional Abuse, and Sacrilege within the Province of Malta

To the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith, the Vatican Secretariat of State, and the Apostolic Nunciature to Malta Titular Archbishop Wojciech Zaluski:

I am formally transmitting the enclosed "Dossier of Ecclesiastical Misconduct and Institutional Abuse." This comprehensive document outlines an unyielding line of severe administrative and moral infractions within the Archdiocese of Malta, spearheaded by the former Archpriest of Mosta, Albert Buhagiar, and the current Archpriest, Sebastian Caruana, with the absolute rubber-stamping, systemic complicity, and weaponized silence of Archbishop Charles J. Scicluna, Auxiliary Bishop Joe Galea-Curmi, and Bishop Anton Teuma.

The core of this dossier presents undeniable, black-and-white evidence regarding a [calculated police frame-up in 2014](#), where I was falsely accused of a ["violation of tombs"](#) in the Mosta parish crypt — a fabrication the clergy fully recognized as a lie, yet weaponized to ensure my character assassination and indefinite psychiatric confinement. It further details a profound act of physical desecration between 2017 and 2019, wherein Archpriest Caruana unilaterally and unlawfully emptied the historic Mosta parish ossuary, mutilating and discarding rare mummified human remains in total violation of both Maltese civil law and Catholic Canon Law.

A STARK CONTRAST IN ECCLESIASTICAL DISCIPLINE

The profound stonewalling, double standards, and weaponized institutional silence maintained by Archbishop Scicluna and the Maltese Curia stand in a stark, damning contrast to the current standard of global justice being enforced by the Holy See.

On July 2, 2026, the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith and His Holiness Pope Leo XIV demonstrated that the Church can act with immediate, ruthless decisiveness when facing defiance, [issuing swift decrees of excommunication](#) against the bishops and priests of the Society of Saint Pius X (SSPX) in Écône for operating outside the boundaries of Church law and papal authority.

If the Holy See can move with such lightning speed to penalize traditionalist clergy in Switzerland for matters of liturgical and structural governance, the Supreme Authority of the Church cannot logically or morally ignore, amongst others, a senior Archbishop and his Archpriests who have actively covered up human rights abuses, engaged in [character assassination](#) through Church-controlled media, and [physically desecrated](#) the sacred remains of the dead.

The Maltese Church hierarchy operates under the arrogant assumption that their positions place them entirely above accountability and state laws. By choosing silence over a [reasoned, non-escalatory compromise](#), they have forced an open confrontation.

I formally request that the competent Roman Dicasteries launch an immediate apostolic visitation and canonical investigation into the grave, illegal administrative failures and structural rot within the Archdiocese of Malta. The warnings have been delivered, the digital footprint is permanent, and the full weight of the public and legal fallout now rests solely upon the hierarchy that chose the path of corruption.
