Thanks for your reply. I explained the situation in my blog post, where it says you didn't kill the cats. I also wrote you were described as schizophrenic, because as far as I know that was the diagnosis back then - and the reason you were sent to Mount Carmel rather than hospital.

I'm getting in touch with you because I see the injustice being done to you, and I'm interested in investigating these issues. I'm quite familiar with Malta's way of operating and can imagine the position you're currently in feels hopeless.

And to answer you: I haven't befriended many psychiatrists here, I merely saw one during my stay in Mount Carmel and once after I was discharged. I'm not a fan of psychiatry myself, but I trusted back then that it was the most efficient way of getting out of my psychotic episode. For me, it worked.

Look, I'm willing to have a look at your side of the story and see if there's anything I can do. We don't have to agree on whether mental illness is real or not. However, if you don't trust me or my views, I understand that too.
